The troop has been working very hard to get rank advancements!

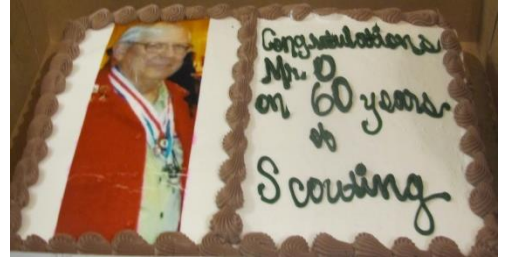
Klondike

We had two people show up for street cleanup this month: Noah and Wyatt. Thank you! Next time, let's get more people there!



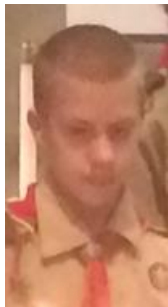
Elections in March
